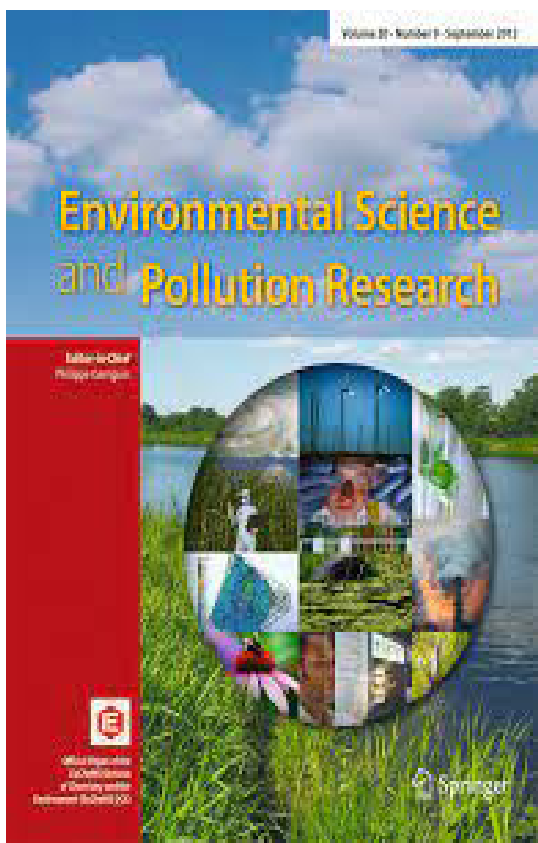


Call for papers on 2022 Special issue (Marine Pollution and Ecological Degradation - MPAED-2022)
